Orders / Commands	<p>He said to us: “Stay here”</p> <p>She said to him: “Don’t move!”</p>	<p>He told us <u>to</u> stay there.</p> <p>She ordered him <u>not to</u> move.</p>
Suggestions	<p>“Let’s make a cake!”, she said</p> <p>“Why don’t we make a cake?”, she said</p> <p>“Shall we make a cake?”, she said</p> <p>“Let’s not leave the room”, they said</p>	<p>She suggested <u>making</u> a cake.</p> <p>“ “ that we <u>should</u> make a cake.</p> <p>They suggested <u>not leaving</u> the room.</p> <p>“ “ that we <u>shouldn’t</u> leave the room.</p>
