

VOCABULARY Sport



In this unit, the topic vocabulary is related to sport.

Remind students to use the *Outlook 2 Interactive Student (IS)* to prepare for this lesson at home. Alternatively, you may want to use the *Outlook 2 Interactive Classroom (IC)* material to present the vocabulary in class or to test your students' familiarity with the vocabulary.

Remind students that there is a full **glossary** at the back of the Student's Book on pages 108-116.

- 1 Tell students to match statements 1-5 in A to the correct answer (a-g) in B. Remind them to pay attention to the words in colour. Point out that there are two extra answers. When they finish, tell students to check their answers on page 44 of the Student's Book.

ANSWERS

LOOKING AT LANGUAGE

Point out that the word *mates* means *partners* and it is often formed with other words to form new words e.g. *teammates*.

Ask students what other words that are listed can be used with *mates*. Ask them how they say these words in their language.

ANSWERS

classmates, flatmates, roommates

- 2 Tell students to replace the words in bold with a word or phrase listed that has a similar meaning.

- 3 Tell students to read the sentences and decide if the sentences are true or false. Then, tell them to correct the false sentences without changing the words in bold. Check students' understanding of *deliberately* (sentence 4) and *achievements* (sentence 5).

ANSWERS

- 3 False – A setback **takes you away** from your goal.

- 4 Tell students to answer the questions paying attention to the words in bold. Check students' understanding of the noun *score* (sentence 3).

POSSIBLE ANSWERS

- 1 the Champions League, the NBA, the Football World Cup
- 2 basketball, high jump, football, rugby
- 3 Team A's score is higher.
- 4 silver medal
- 5 He / She should play fairly.

OPTIONAL ACTIVITY: VOCABULARY

For further practice, you can ask students the following questions for class discussion:

- 1 Have you ever won a **championship**? What award were you given?
- 2 How do you stay **in good shape** and **keep fit**? Do you **work out** in the gym? How often?
- 3 Why are athletes such as Rafa Nadal, Iker Casillas and Pau Gasol considered **role models**?



- 5 Ask students what other words they know connected to sport. Tell them to think of different equipment, locations and actions related to sport.

POSSIBLE ANSWERS

cardio exercises, cool down, running track, stretching, tennis court, treadmill, weights

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
